

Teacher Moves that Helped or Hindered Student Learning

“Funneling” student thinking – guiding students through a procedure to reach a particular, teacher-centered conclusion. Funneling directs student thinking.

“Focusing” student thinking – encouraging students to express their understanding and articulate how they would solve the problem. Focusing makes student thinking visible.
