University Credit at PCMI

Executive Summary

- Credit is for Mathematics 497: Math Topics for Teachers from the University of Washington
- Six quarter credits = 4 semester credits
- Cost is \$225. Payment by credit card or check.
- No letter grade: Grade is *Credit* (or *No Credit*)
- No additional work for credit beyond full participation in PCMI TLP.

Big Question: Grad Credit or Not?

- Important point: There is no official US definition of "graduate credit" or "graduate-level credit". It really depends on your local institution, state, district, etc.
- Can tell you this: This course can be and has been used for credit for UW Masters and Doctoral students in education and Masters students in Math. And it has been used by many, many PCMI teachers – but occasionally requiring extra effort and documentation.
